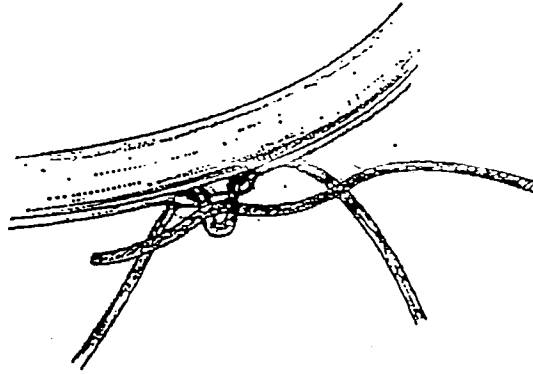


Net Attachment Instructions

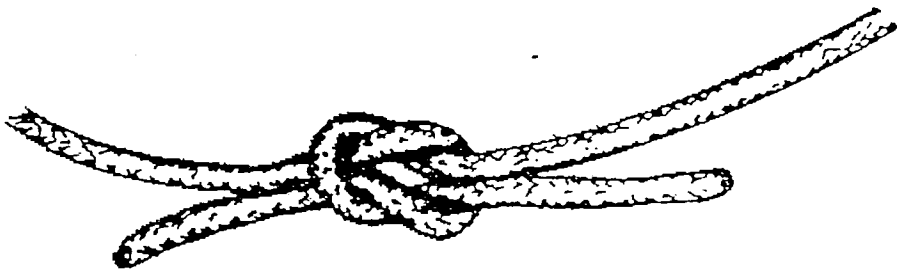
Starting at the front of the goal ring, insert one of the long loops on the net through the attachment ring opening—just far enough to thread the tie cord through the eye of the loop so that the tie cord is to the outside of the ring.



Check to be certain that the net is hanging in the proper position and that the loops are free of any twists before inserting.

In a similar manner, attach the remaining loops working around both sides toward the rear of the goal.

After the tie cord is through the twelve loops, pull the net down gently until the tie cord and all net loops are snug against the attachment ring. Pull all of the slack out of the tie cord, taking care not to pull the net loops back through the attachment ring openings.



With all of the slack out of the cord and the loops against the ring, tie a square knot tightly in the cord.

Any excess cord can be cutoff or hidden by tucking in behind the cover plate.
